



Intraspecific diversity in reaction norms of beech seedlings

Global change is putting a lot of pressure on communities and ecosystem worldwide. It is, therefore, crucial for us to understand how trees respond to these new environmental conditions.

Using a beech seedlings common garden experiment with 180 beech saplings from all over Europe, you will find out how different levels of drought (from mild to severe) affects beech seedlings. Using leaf spectroscopy, we will be able to measure an integrative plant phenotype. Will the genetic background of a seedling affect these reaction norms? You can find out ©
